Events also qualify for Continuing Professional Development hours required for recognition as a Registered Wood Energy or Biogas Adviser.

It says that they are taking time to ensure their technical knowledge is up-to-speed and that they are taking an opportunity to learn from the experiences from their peers. Non-members are welcome to register and attend all events on payment of a full fee to cover set up and admin costs.
